The first section, in the minor mode, should be played with much energy and careful attention to articulation markings to achieve the desired rhythmic vitality. The second section, in the relative major, should be more flowing in nature with the triplet patterns of its melody providing an effective contrast to the rbythmic motives of the first section. The final statement of this section should be full and majestic before the transition back to "Dal Segno."

The tempo of this march should remain constant and should allou for the sixteenth note patterns to be played cleanly and evenly.
