## PROGRAM NOTES

Leroy Anderson (1908–1975), the dean of American concert light music, continues to delight audiences worldwide with his highly entertaining, tune-centered works. As composer and conductor John Williams is quoted saying: "Anderson's music remains as young and fresh as the very day on which it was composed."

This medley presents six of Anderson's most well-known and loved creations (in order of appearance):

### *Plink! Plank! Plunk*

Originally written for string orchestra, this lively romp was used as the theme song for the CBS game show *I've Got a Secret* for over two decades.

### *The Syncopated Clock*

As many of his works were, Anderson wrote this for Arthur Fiedler and the Boston Pops Orchestra. The composer conducted the premiere performance while still serving in the U. S. Army in 1945.

### *Forgotten Dreams*

This timeless tune, an overnight success when it was released in 1954, still appears on concert programs and in films sixty years later.

### *Blue Tango*

Anderson's first big hit reached the number one single slot on *Billboard* in 1952. Lyricist Mitchell Parish later penned a text to be sung to the tune.

### *A Trumpeter's Lullaby*

Written at the request of the Boston Pops first chair trumpet player, Roger Voison, it was recorded by him in 1950, and remains a vital part of the trumpet repertoire today.

### *Fiddle-Fiddle*

Another work originally conceived for strings, this title became a favorite of Boston Pops audiences through the years, and is one of Anderson's most recorded works.

## NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

Encourage players to use 'toh' for all staccato notes throughout the arrangement, thereby insuring a solid tonal presence and correct stylistic duration.

Dynamics on all melody parts have been notated one or two levels above surrounding accompaniment parts. Faithful observation of dynamic markings will insure proper balance.

Tempo markings are to be considered approximate. Feel free to adjust accordingly to meet the needs of the ensemble. Also, though not marked, it is understood that the sections beginning at measure 28 and measure 91 are to be played at the same tempi as the previous sections.

"A Trumpeter's Lullaby" (mm. 91-106) may be played as a trumpet solo in one of two ways: (1) solo player on trumpet 1, omitting trumpet 2 part; (2) solo players on trumpet 1 and trumpet 2.
