PROGRAM NOTES

Tribal War Chant is based on authentic Native American war dances. The music to these dances was very rhythmic and consisted of human voices accompanied by drums, bells, and rattles. Before a war, men danced to attain spirit and power; after a war, they danced to celebrate a victory.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

The opening flute solo may also be played by a solo piccolo or by the entire flute section. Be very careful that the low winds do not overpower the solo here. The tom-tom part that begins at measure 7 will be most effective if more than one player is used, either by adding additional toms or snare drums with the snares turned off. Best wishes for an exciting performance!
