In 2008 the trombonist, Chris Jeans, was invited to be a featured soloist at a British Trombone Society event. By way of Studio Music Company he contacted me to see if I had any new material for trombone. I had already written a piece for another trombone player, Brett Baker, Shout, which was programmed for the same event so we needed to find something new for Chris.

The title *Blue Jeans* came to my mind, thus linking a blues-style piece with the obvious reference to Chris's surname. Chris liked the sound of it so then I had to go away and write a solo to match the title. I managed to get a version with piano accompaniment done in time for Chris to perform at the trombone event and have now had a chance to complete the band version.

Chris is a great chap, a good friend and a vonderful trombone player
