

The Composer

Craig Skeffington has been the band director at South Portland High School in Maine since 1994. His performing groups have won numerous honors during that time, including the Maine State Jazz Festival 8 times; the Berklee College of Music Festival twice, in 1995 and again in 2001; and MusicFest Orlando once, in 2001. In 2003, Craig was awarded *Music Educator of the Year* by the Maine Music Educator's Association. He has been Maine's Jazz Activities Vice - President as well as it's Instrumental Jazz Chair. Craig has also served as President of the Maine Band Director's Association. This past year, Craig was recognized by the national magazine *School Band and Orchestra* as one of the "50 band directors that make a difference" of 2007.

As a New England area trumpet player, Craig has a wide variety of performance credits. These include working with Natalie Cole, Barry Manilow, Colin Raye, the Glenn Miller Big Band, the New York Voices and touring with the Artie Shaw Orchestra. As a member of the New Hampshire based Seacoast Big Band, Craig has performed with artists such as Bobby Shew, Louis Bellson, Bob Mintzer, Frank Foster, Clark Terry and Bob Florence.

As a composer and arranger, Craig has studied with Bob Florence, Toshiko Akioishi and Don Stratton. His pieces appear in the most recent JW Pepper catalog and NYSSMA manual, as well as having been reviewed in the *International Association of Jazz Educator's Journal*. In December of 2007, his music was programed at the prestigious Mid - West Band and Orchestra clinic in Chicago. His music is published by the Neil A. Kjos Music Company in San Diego, Ca.; by Alfred/Belwin Music (formerly Warner Brothers); and by Manduca Music in Portland, ME. Groups ranging from middle school jazz bands to college and military bands have performed his music. Craig is currently an adjunct staff member at the University of Southern Maine where he teaches applied jazz arranging. Craig currently resides in South Portland with his wife Carrie and their two daughters, Hannah and Molly.

The Composition

The Molly March is a Second Line piece that I wrote for my daughter Molly back in 2006. Mostly this request came from Molly herself in response to her big sister having a tune named for her ("The Hannah Shuffle") back in 2000! I wanted to do something different with this composition, not just "another" swing piece. I really like the groove of the Second Line feel, and the harmony is influenced by the great pop musician Sting, whose music I love.

The term *Second Line* refers to the traditional New Orleans funeral procession. The music played as the procession moved from the church to the cemetery was slow and mournful. Following the service, the procession leading back to the church was accompanied by more rousing music. Passersby and others who were not a part of the funeral often joined this part of the procession, forming a "second line" behind the original mourners.

In preparing the piece, work for a light feel in the rhythm section, especially with the Drummer. The Second Line groove is generated primarily by the snare, be careful on the volume. On the bridge at measure 25, the groove changes up slightly - almost to a Hip Hop feel, returning to the Second Line at measure 41. Keep the band volume under the muted Trumpets just prior to the solo section. On the Sax soli at measure 111, encourage the Lead Alto to dig in and be aggressive with tons of support from the whole section. As the piece builds towards the final shout at measures 143 and 151, work for band balance at the high dynamic level and have the drums really go after kicking the band's figures. As the chart winds down, have the Saxes stagger breathe to keep the chord sounding until the final resolution. I hope that you find this piece as interesting as Molly does, and that your group enjoys putting it together. Best of luck! Craig
